1. The dates for the final exam are Tuesday the 3rd of January and Tuesday the 17th of January 2017, both in Room B126 (Institute of Cybernetics) from 14:00 to 17:30.
2. The final exam will consist in three exercises, for a total of 30 points, and 20 free-form answer questions, each worth one point.
A partially completed exercise will be given a partial score. A wrong answer to a question will give zero points.
3. The score of the midterm will be converted in the standard zero-to-five score following the guidelines in the course assessment criteria:

from 45 to 50	5
from 40 to 44	4
from 35 to 39	3
from 30 to 34	2
from 25 to 29	1
below 15	0

4. The scores of the final exam, the midterm, and the classroom presentation concur to the final score according to the criteria written in the syllabus.
Taking the final exam is necessary for passing the course with a sufficient mark. The marks of the midterm and of the classroom presentation are not counted until the final exam is taken.
5. If a student does not take the final exam, or does not return the assignment, a “no show” mark will be given.
If a student takes the exam on both dates, but does not return the assignment the second time, the score of the first date will be final.
If a student takes the exam on both dates, and does return the assignment the second time, the score of the second time will be final even if lower than that of the first one.

6. Only handwritten notes are allowed.

In particular: books, printouts, or photocopied notes are not allowed.

7. Use of electronic devices is absolutely forbidden.

Before the beginning of the exam you will be asked to turn off your cell phones and put them on the instructor's desk.

8. It is forbidden to leave the room without having returned the assignment.

Exception: A single break of up to five minutes is allowed. In this case, the assignment must be given to the instructor before leaving the room, and will be given back upon re-entering the room.
